


MODERATION

- Facilitates evidence-based decision-making




DIFFERENTIATION

- -Creates multiple entry points for learning





The TASK

engages learners


- -Focuses on big ideas and enduring understandings of *The Ontario Curriculum*
- -Inspires open-ended inquiry that reflects authentic, relevant and meaningful contexts
- -Promotes creativity, innovation, critical thinking and problem-solving



FEEDBACK

guides learners

- -**Provides** ongoing, descriptive, precise, and timely information
- -Invites peer and self assessment (focuses on assessment "as" and "for" learning)
- -Identifies strengths and next steps for improvement



CRITERIA

informs learners

- -Defines learning goals
- -*Establishes* success criteria
- -Scaffolds learning through co-created anchor charts, exemplars, and qualitative rubrics
